CHAPTER 1. EXPLOSIVE STORAGE MAGAZINE ALARMS

SEC. 35.101. TYPE 1 EXPLOSIVES MAGAZINE.

"Type 1 explosives magazine" shall mean magazines for the permanent storage of explosives as defined in Section 55.203(a) and 55.207 of Part 55 of Title 27 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

SEC. 35.102. PERMIT.

It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, sell, furnish, give away, receive, transport, use, store or possess explosives without first having made application for and received a permit in accordance with the provisions of Section 12101 of the California Health and Safety Code.

SEC. 35.103. ALARM.

- (a) No person shall be issued an Explosives Permit by the Issuing Authority until it has been determined a Direct Dial Device has been installed on any Type 1 explosives magazine owned, used or under the management and/or supervision of the applicant. This alarm system may be either in the magazine itself or on a perimeter fence.
- (b) "Direct Dial Device" shall mean a device which is connected to a telephone line and upon activation of an alarm system automatically dials a predetermined telephone number and transmits a message or signal indicating a need for an emergency response.
- (c) No direct dial device or any direct line equipment which when activated shall be equipped to automatically dial a telephone number in or signal directly any office of the Sheriff's Department.

SEC. 35.104. MAINTENANCE.

Failure to maintain such Direct Dial Device in proper working order shall result in the revocation of the Explosives Permit. Such permit may be reinstated upon proof of compliance with this chapter.
